I want to make an international doctoral degree, what is it?



Real Decreto 99/2011, January 28

Article 15. International doctoral degree and thesis with international co-supervision.

Students may be awarded an "international doctoral degree", if the following requirements are met:




a) During the period of study required for the doctoral degree, they have spent at least three months outside Spain at a leading research centre or higher education institution to conduct research or further their studies.




The stay and the activities must be endorsed by the supervisor and authorized by the Academic Committee, and they must be included in the student's activity report.





b) Part of the doctoral thesis (at least the abstract and the conclusions) must be written and presented in one of the languages commonly used for scientific communication in the field in question, a language other than Spanish or the co-official languages of Spain. This requirement shall not be applied to stays, reports or experts in or from Spanish-speaking countries.




c) The thesis must include input from at least two experts (with PhDs) from a research centre or higher education institution outside Spain.




d) At least one expert (with a PhD) from a research centre or higher education institution outside Spain, and not the person responsible for the stay mentioned in paragraph a), must form part of the thesis examination panel.

The doctoral degree certificate will state on the reverse side: "Thesis co-supervised with the University of X", if the following requirements are met:



a) The thesis is supervised by two or more supervisors (with PhDs) from two universities, one Spanish and one from outside Spain. There must be a co-supervision agreement signed by the two universities.



b) During the period of study required for the doctoral degree, the student has spent at least six months (in one or more stays) conducting research at the institution the co-supervision agreement is signed with. Any stays and activities must be included in the activity report.
